Categories for Section Entry

All overall entries will automatically be entered into section contests.

Literary Magazines will be entered in the following section contests: Cover Design, Theme Development, Photography, Layout, Art, Poetry, Fiction, Nonfiction and Social Media.

Yearbooks will be entered in the following section contests: Cover Design, Photography, Coverage, Theme, Advertising, Layout, Copy and Social Media.

Broadcast News and Radio/Podcast will be entered in the following section contests: Audio, Video, Production, Editing and Social Media.

Guidelines for Individual Contest Entry
